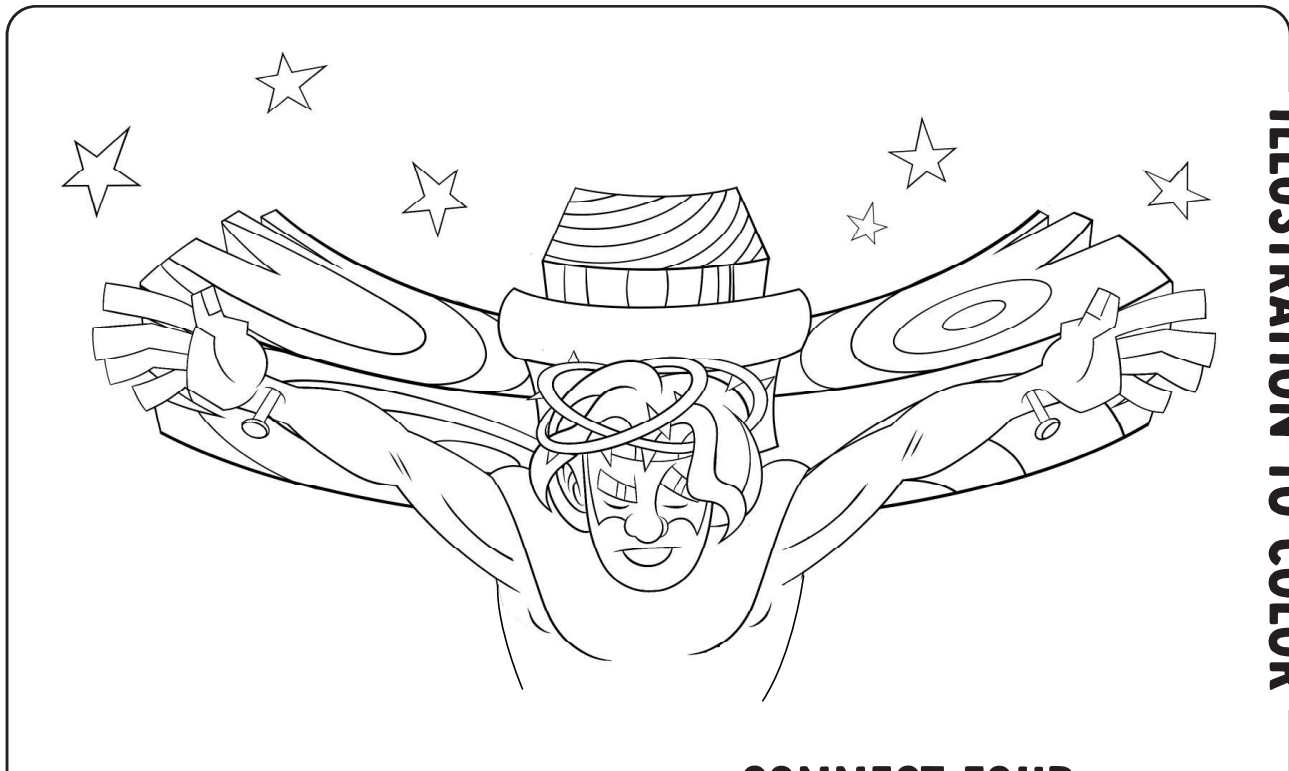

REBUS PUZZLE

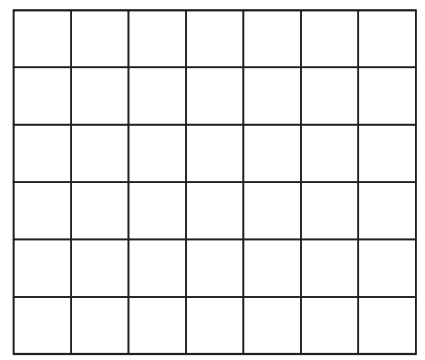
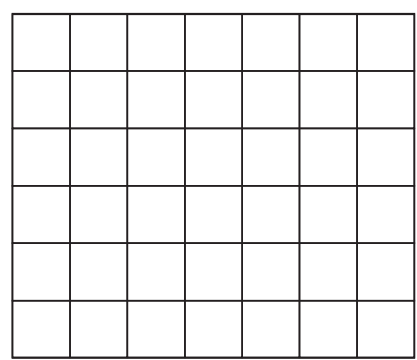
